7. Supported 17 trained Hairdressers and Beauticians of (GHABA Wassa Akropong zone) with hand dryers and cash donation.



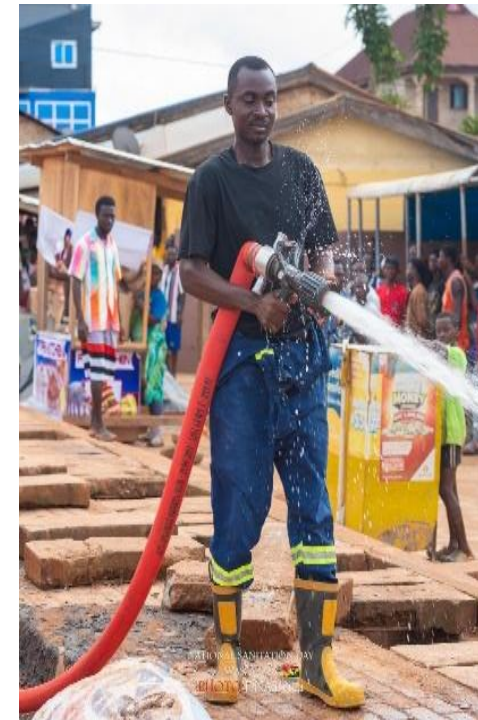

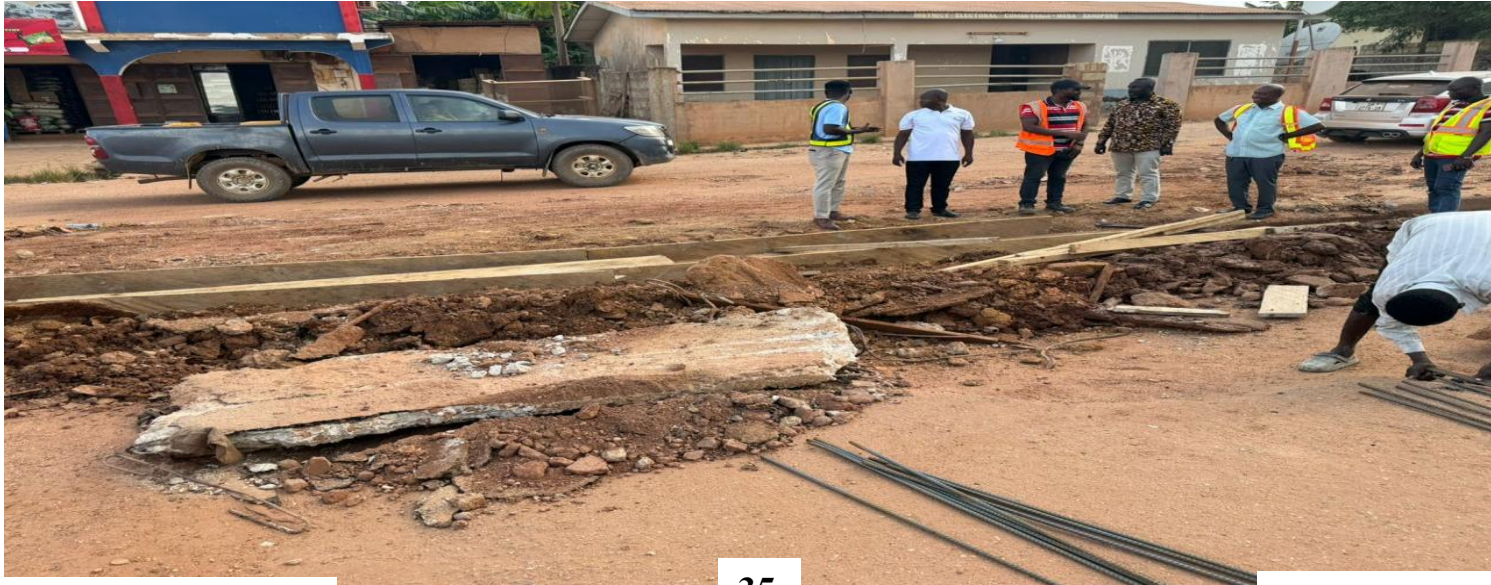
26. Donated **GHC 10,000** to Sis. Rebecca, who lost her properties as a result of severe fire outbreak.

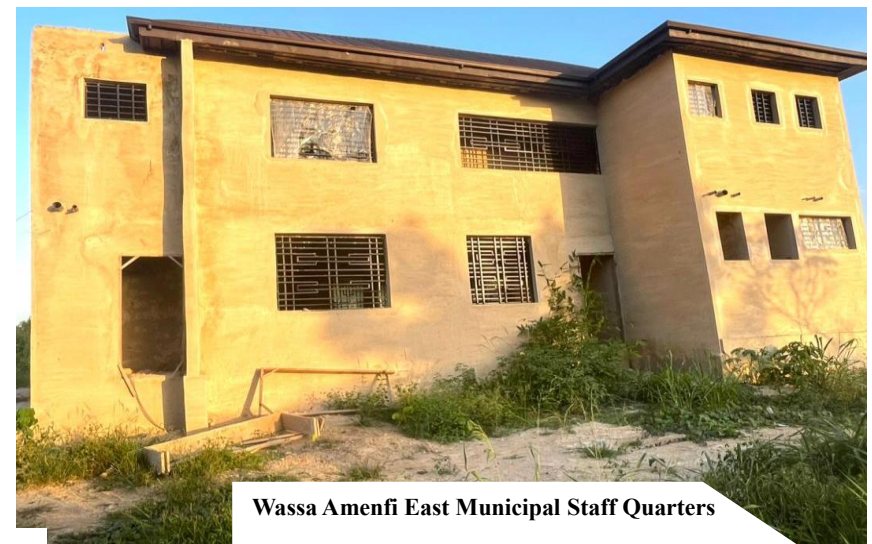

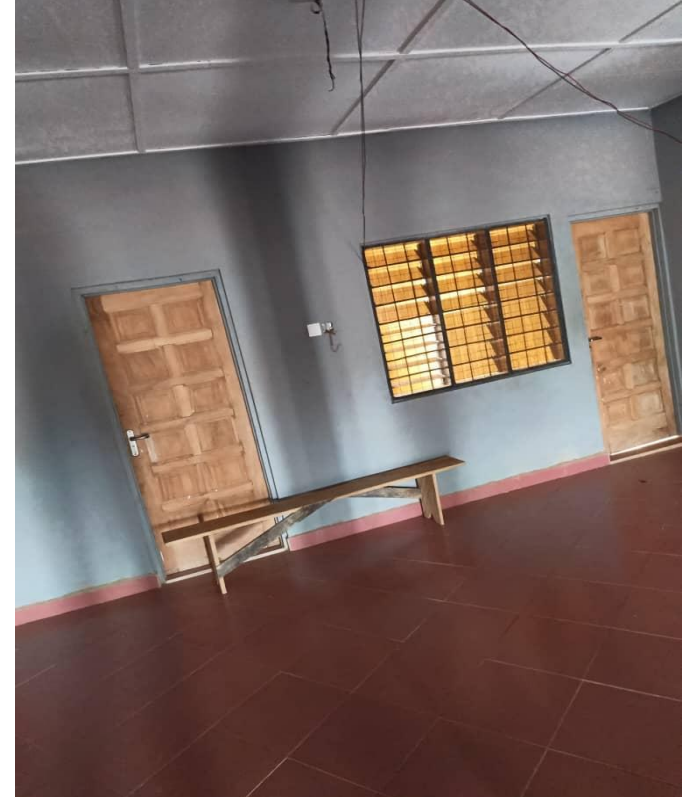
